Dear Parents/Carers,

We want to provide some reminders about our academy uniform policy and rules. Please go over these with your child to make sure they understand what is expected before they return to school on Monday 15th January.

For Key Stage 3 Students (Years 7 to 9):

Students must wear the Dixons Brooklands blazer and tie at all times. There are no exceptions unless previously agreed with parents.

For Key Stage 4 Students (Years 10 and 11):

Students may choose their uniform (business wear) from the selection of approved options. This must include a grey, black or navy blazer. However, students in these year groups must not wear the Key Stage 3 tie or blazer.

Jewellery:

The only permitted jewellery items are:

- One watch
- One pair of simple stud earrings.

No other jewellery is allowed. Necklaces, bracelets, rings etc. will be confiscated if worn and will be kept in a safe. Students will be able to collect their belongings at the end of the school day. Refusing to hand over jewellery may result in a sanction being issued.

Nails:

Fingernails should be natural. Acrylics, gel nails or other artificial enhancements are not permitted under any circumstances.

Coats:

Students may wear coats outdoors and in the canteen. Coats must be removed when in the corridors and in classrooms.

If there are any uniform issues that need to be adjusted, students will be required to address them immediately at the start of the academy day. Refusal to comply may result in a sanction being issued. Please ensure your child follows these policies.
