initial observations is that we need to open our communication channels more, and I will be asking our teaching staff to speak with you more to let you know when your children are doing well.


I have also noted that there are a number of students not complying with both our mobile phone and uniform policies. You should have received a letter from me today outlining our expectations.

A reminder:

The **GCSE Spanish speaking** exams begin week beginning 15th April. As with other exams, attendance is compulsory. AQA awards marks very generously for the speaking exam and students are generally very successful when they are confident on their answers.
